Dear Herscher School Community,

As a result of the investigation done by the Herscher High School administration and the Herscher Police Department, we believe there is NO threat to student safety at Herscher High School. As a precaution, the District has asked an officer from the Herscher Police Department to be on our premises for an undetermined time. To repeat, this is a cautionary measure and is NOT because we believe there is any imminent threat to school safety.

Further, I want to personally apologize to those folks who were not notified of the situation in our previous announcement this week. It was our intent to notify all PreK-12 parents, faculty and staff of the incident, but apparently there was a "glitch/error" in the School Messenger system. This error/glitch in our School Messenger system has since been fixed, so everyone will be notified in the future, if there is a serious event at one of our schools.

Finally, it is our goal to share all pertinent information with the school community in the following ways:

- 1. Message may be sent via phone (Sometimes message, like this one, are too long to deliver via phone).
- 2. Message will be sent via e-mail.
- 3. Message will be sent via text message (Text message has a limit of 160 characters, so often times it is shorter or will direct you to e-mail).
- 4. Message will be posted via Facebook (District and/or School).
- 5. Message will be posted on the District website.

We hope these forms of communication will reach everyone. Again, if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
