Holiday Gift Ideas for Musicians

<u>ALL:</u>

- Music Stand (either folding or metal)
- Instrument stand (Hercules makes very sturdy ones)
- Metronome and Tuner
 - o Look for both in one, Sabine MT-9000 is very good
 - Anything by Korg is sturdy and will hold up
 - o Tonal Energy (phone app)- this is what we use in class daily
- Private Lessons (ask for recommendations)

Woodwinds

- Mouthpiece Upgrade (Talk to me for recommendations!)
- Ligature Upgrade (talk to me for recommendations!)
- Cleaning cloth or pull swab
- Reeds
 - o Vandoren, Rico Royal, Rico
 - 5/6: 2.5 Strength
 - 7/8: 3 strength
- Neck Strap (one with nice padding and possibly a metal instead of plastic hook)
- Cork Grease
- Reed case (one that holds two or four reeds- cases allow the reeds to properly dry and set after playing)

<u>Brass</u>

Mouthpiece Upgrade!

- This is the best thing you can do for a young musician
- Stick to brand names, Bach, Schilke, etc.
- Trumpets should be on 5C or 3C by 8th grade
- o Trombones should be on a 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ AL, 7C or 5G
- o Tubas I recommend
- Berp- Buzz Extension and Resistance Piece
 - Helps your tone and reach the higher notes
- Polishing cloth
- Mouthpiece brush
- Mutes
 - Harmon, straight (used most often), cup, plunger

Percussion

- Soft, medium and hard yarn mallets
- Soft, medium and hard rubber mallets
- Timpani Mallets
- Snare Sticks
 - o SD1 General (concert band)
 - Vic Firth 7A (Jazz band)
- Pitch Pipe (timpani tuning)
- Stick Bag
- Practice Pad
- Drum key
