Head Start Program located at Herscher Intermediate School

***The following information only applies if the district is continuing to follow
COVID-19 guidelines implemented January 2021***

1. Remote Learning is available for all preschool students including special services.
2. After-School Child Care (2:05 PM- 3:05 PM) is available for preschool students. To enroll, go to the district website www.hcusd2.org >Community Info Page, then scroll down.
3. The Head Start Program will operate on the Kankakee School District #111, Head Start calendar.
4. The Head Start program runs Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 2:05 pm, for in-person learning.
5. A sack lunch or hot lunch will be provided by the program, menus can be found at www.hcusd2.org -under Food Services, Lunch Menus. There are no lunch fees.
6. If you have requested school bus transportation, your bus stop location and pick up/drop off times will be made available to you either the week before school starts in August or after the completion of the online registration process. Depending on when your child starts school.
7. An adult (at least 18-years of age) must be present at the assigned bus stop for both pick up and drop off. The child must be buckled into a bus safety seat by the adult and unbuckled from the seat at the end of the day. By law, the bus driver cannot leave his/her seat.
8. Supplies:
 - a. A child-sized mask or neck gaiter. Please be sure the child's mask fits properly and is comfortable for all day wear.
 - b. A full-size book bag
 - c. A small blanket (throw-sized) or beach towel for rest time.
 - d. All other supplies are provided by the program.
