## STATE OF ILLINOIS IMMUNIZATION PRESCHOOL REQUIREMENTS FOR 2020-2021

SCHOOL PHYSICAL EXAM: For first year preschool students only.

A school physical exam must be performed by a physician in the state of Illinois and recorded on the current *Certificate of Child Health Examination* form (obtained from your doctor.) The physical examination must be completed within one calendar year prior to the date of school entry. The exam form must include up-to-date Immunizations and Medical History signed by the parent.

Physical Due Date: First Day of School. Deadline October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Students who do not submit a school physical will be excluded per Illinois Law, until all forms are turned in, or if you provide a signed notice from your child's physician of the scheduled appointment.

## **REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS:**

| DTP or DTaP (Diphtheria,<br>Tetanus and Pertussis)     | 3 doses by 1 year of age, one additional booster dose by 2 <sup>nd</sup> birthday  |

| OPV or IPV (Polio)                                     | 2 doses by 1 year of age, one additional dose by 2 <sup>nd</sup> birthday with a total of 3 or more doses                          |
| MMR: Measles, Mumps & Rubella                          | 1 dose on or after the 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday but prior to 24 months of age  |
| Hepatitis B  | 3 doses for all children 2 years of age or older. The 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose must have been administered on or after 6 months of age |
| Lead Screening  1 <sup>st</sup> year preschoolers only | 1 lead screening or lead screening questionnaire is required for 1 <sup>st</sup> year preschoolers only                            |
| Varicella (Chickenpox)                                 | 1 dose on or after the 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday or statement from healthcare provider of varicella history of past infection       |
| Hib – Haemophilus<br>influenza type b                  | Children 15-59 months without series must have one dose after 15 months of age   |
| PCV – Invasive<br>Pneumococcal Disease                 | Children without series must have one dose between 24-59 months of age   |
| TB test  | RECOMMENDED – If your child resides in an area as having a high incidence of tuberculosis.   |

Immunizations Due Date: First Day of School. Immunization requirements subject to change per IDPH immunization requirements.

## **NECESSARY MEDICATIONS: All Grade Levels**

A *Medication Consent Form* must be completed by your doctor and on file, if your child is to receive necessary medications at school. You may obtain these forms from our district website <a href="www.hcusd2.org">www.hcusd2.org</a> (under Student Registration) or from your school's main office.

Medication Consent Form Due Date: First day of school or before student is to receive medication during the school year.

Vision & hearing screenings are mandated per IDPH & ISBE for preschool. Please put in writing to the school nurse is you do not want your child screened for vision and hearing during the school year.
