

Lee Braford Scholarship For Dedication to Community Service

The Bourbonnais Friendship Festival, Inc, is a nonprofit organization dedicated to family oriented recreation and to the financial support of numerous community organizations. This scholarship has been created to honor the memory of an individual who was a long time festival leader and volunteer. Upon his passing in January of 2007, those people who were touched by his dedication to this community, his selflessness, generosity and giving spirit, donated the money to create this award.

It is the intention of the Bourbonnais Friendship Festival that this scholarship award be granted to an individual whose values reflect those of the late Mr. Leeman Braford and that the \$500.00 stipend is used to support future college or vocational training goals.

Eligibility

To be considered for this scholarship the applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Must be active in community service projects and/or volunteer opportunities.
2. A Kankakee County high school senior scheduled to graduate this year.
3. Have plans to attend college or enroll in a vocational training program.

Recipient of this scholarship will be chosen on the basis of eligibility, application, essay and references.

The Bourbonnais Friendship Festival shows no bias toward students of any particular race, religion, creed, gender or involvement in any specific volunteer project(s).

Application Guidelines

- Application due on or before April 30, 2026
- Print or type application.
- Essays are to be submitted in paper format and between 150-300 words.
- One letter of recommendation from an individual who is intimately aware of the applicant's involvement in community service.
