

The Education Advisory Committee, under the auspices of the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Memorial Foundation, formed the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Academic Scholarship Fund.

The Foundation provides financial awards to graduating high school seniors from Kankakee County who demonstrate academic ability, financial need, good general character, and a desire to attend college.

Goals of the Scholarship Program

- 1. To provide financial assistance to deserving Kankakee County graduating high school seniors
- 2. To allow for the development of potential leaders from Kankakee County
- 3. To recognize high school graduates who have demonstrated service to the school, community, or church, as well as good academic ability and a financial need

Procedures for applying (all four must be submitted)

- 1. Complete the scholarship application
- 2. Attach an official high school transcript or statement signed by high school counselor showing Grade Point Average (GPA).

 Official ACT or SAT scores are OPTIONAL.
- 3. Write in your own style, using your own words, the answers to these four questions: (Use page 6 of the form or a separate sheet of paper)
 - a. Please tell us about yourself. How do you view yourself in terms of school now and in the future?
 - a. What are your future goals?
 - b. Where do you think you need the most improvement (academically, socially, personally, or other)?
 - c. How would you benefit from the MLK, Jr., Scholarship?
- 4. Attach a copy (to this application) of the ACCEPTANCE LETTER from your college of choice.
