## Parent Appreciation & Information

Thank you for partnering with us in the unprecedented days ahead. Our staff has been working diligently over the past week to prepare the best possible learning experience for your children and we recognize you as parent/guardian(s) will also be going above and beyond on behalf of your child's education in the coming days. As you are aware, school will be closed March 17-30, 2020. All before and after school activities are cancelled during this time frame. E-learning Days are scheduled March 17– 20 and on March 30. ## Student Learning

Limestone Middle School will be using Google Classroom as the platform for e-learning. LMS students are familiar and utilize this platform regularly at school. Teachers will post assignments by 830A daily and students will login from home to access, complete and submit assignments. Additional supports and resources such as textbooks and paper packets were sent home with students on Monday, March 16.

## OPTIONAL RECOMMENDED STUDENT SCHEDULE
